Sub: Use of Pre-printed GAR-7 Challan under the EASIEST Pilot project –reg.

The attention of the Trade is invited to Trade Notice no. 16/2005 dt.14.6.2005 under which a new format GAR-7 for Central Excise Tax payment (Receipt & payment Rules 226) was communicated along with the procedure to be adopted for payment of Central Excise duty by the assesseees in the designated Banks.

An analysis of the data of the payments received from the Banks shows problems with respect to the data transmitted by the Banks to the Department based on the data furnished in GAR-7 forms by the assesseees. One of the most important fields on the challans is the assessee code field in order to give due credit to the assessee on the system for the amount paid by him at the Bank.

Therefore, it has been decided that the challans with pre-printed assessee code along with name, address and location code be used by the assesseees for payment of duty at the designated Banks. This arrangement is similar to the one that is being implemented under OLTAS scheme for Income Tax payments.

To facilitate the availability of the pre-printed challans to the assesseees as above, a web-page utility has since been developed and the same is placed on assesseees' specific web-site, [http://exciseand servicetax.nic.in](http://exciseand.servicetax.nic.in). This web-site can be easily assessed by inputting assessee code (ECC) and GAR-7 format containing location code name and address of the assessee will be automatically generated and the assesseees will need

to fill up the amount to be deposited against each account head and then take a print-out of the GAR-7 form for depositing the amount with the designated Bank.

In case the assesseees are not able to generate the GAR-7 forms in the said web-site, the Range officer is being instructed to make available the challan forms with pre-printed data as above. The assessee can collect the sample pre-printed challan forms from the Range office and make copies of the same for further use.

The above procedure for use of pre-printed challan forms for excise duty payments at the designated Banks will take effect immediately and in any case not later than 1.6.2006.
